Powell Hall which we use for all the orchestral events, is at the main school which is a 10-15 minute walk or 5 minute drive from Lupton House. Participants arriving on Saturday or Sunday, particularly if non-residential should go straight to Powell Hall LA10 5HG.

Dates/Times 5pm Friday 5th April (at Lupton House) to 4.00pm Sunday 7th April

Things to bring:

- ❖ A named music stand
- ❖ Any ensemble music that you may want to play
- ❖ A towel (bedding is provided but not towels)
- ❖ Any food and drink (alcoholic/non-alcoholic) you might want extra to the meals. (Tea and coffee are available all the time in a kitchen area)
- ❖ Swimming gear if you wish to use the pool (7-8am only)
- ❖ Warm clothes & hot water bottle MAY be needed (Powell Hall was very cold last year!)

Instruments

Please bring all instruments ie flautists bring piccs, clarinets bring basses etc. There is a piano in Powell Hall

Please don't forget:

Cakes/tray bakes for the rehearsal breaks. Money raised from the sale of cakes and refreshments will be donated to charity and The Cobweb Orchestra.

Parking – please note that we have been specifically requested NOT TO PARK in the school grounds near Lupton House. Any cars left near Lupton House must park in the public car park (chargeable day times) round the corner. There is a small sixth form car park next to the public one which we can use. Only holds 8 cars but useful for unloading. Ample parking is available in the main school car and a limited amount on the road opposite Lupton House though this is often full. **Please adhere to this request from the school in order to avoid problems with them.** Generally after unloading at Lupton, it is easier to then take your car to Powell Hall & leave it there for the weekend, as long as you're OK to walk back & forth between venues.
