

## **Cobweb Orchestra Events**

## **Players Checklist**

There are no legally binding restrictions on our activities at present, but going into winter we must continue to take precautions against spreading infection so that our members feel safe, and to protect the reputation of the Cobweb Orchestra. Please read the guidelines below and commit to them when you attend an event.

- 1. Do not attend if you have Covid symptoms (fever, persistent cough, loss of taste/smell), you are self-isolating for any reason, or you are waiting for a test result. If you had recent contact with a case, please do not attend unless you have a negative PCR test.
- 2. If you have been sent a link to download music in advance, please print it and bring it with you if you can.
- 3. Bring your own refreshments.
- 4. Arrive in good time to allow safe set up of the orchestra.
- 5. Players will be well spaced, and distancing of 2m will be in place for everyone who wants it. If some people wish to stand or sit closer together, they may do so provided they all agree. However, another person's wish to remain 2m from you MUST be respected at all times.
- 6. You are very strongly urged to wear a face-covering at all times indoors except when playing, eating or drinking. You may need more than one mask, and a plastic bag in which to store them. Paper masks are better tolerated than cloth ones.
- 7. Please bring hand-sanitiser and use it often.
- 8. Remain in your seat throughout the rehearsal, other than to use the toilets or to leave for a mandatory rehearsal break.
- 9. There will be breaks on playing during which doors and windows in the rehearsal room will be open to aid ventilation. During breaks, you may be asked to leave the room, so please be prepared for this and dress accordingly. You may be allowed to stay indoors if there is adequate space in the venue.
- 10. If possible, keep all your personal belongings next to your seat.
- 11. Wind/brass players please bring paper or fabric towels to collect drips, and a plastic bag to seal these in and take away at the end.
- 12. Avoid chatting or other noise while the conductor is speaking.

Your name, address and phone number will be held by the Cobweb Orchestra for 21 days after the event, and will be shared with the Trustees of the venue if, and only if, they need them for test and trace purposes.
